

Whatever your situation is, you have rights in France

You should be paid every month



You cannot work more than 10 hours per day



Your employer **cannot withhold** part of your salary for a service provided or a fault



You cannot work more than 6 days per week



A written contract protects you!

The minimum monthly salary* is approximately **1219€ net/month** for working 35 hours per week

Even if you are undocumented, you can:

- Seek care in a hospital
- File a complaint with the police



* In 2020. It gets higher every year. In 2018, it was about 1150€

Advices

- Keep your identification documents with you and make copies
- Open a bank account in your own name



- Make sure you have access to decent working and living conditions (meals, shower, hot water, heat, etc.)
- Do not hesitate to ask specific questions
